Saturday 29:

- Double WRS 70m & 50m
 - Recurve & Longbow 70m
 - Compound & Barebow 50m

Sunday 30:

- Repechage head-to-head matches. There will be matches held to shoot for every position. The number of matches required will be dependent on the number of entries in a category.

Entry information

Fee: £50

- There are no single day entries available. National Tour points are awarded only to those who shoot both days.
- (No refunds 28 days prior to the competition date)
- All entries will be treated in accordance with the Archery GB privacy notice.

- Target Elite Master bowman
- Top 30 2023 ranked compound & recurve

- Top 10 in the 2023 National longbow rankings
- Top 16 barebow from the 2023 National Tour rankings

Open entry to all members: Thursday 7 pm on 29 February 2024

Event timings

- Saturday: Registration and equipment inspection from 7:30am, practice ends to start at 8:30am. There will be no practice on Friday night.
- Sunday: Timings to be published on lanseo in advance of the event. Categories will start at varying times throughout the day.

Awards

- The UK Masters Championships will be the overall winner of the head-to-heads.
- There will be score awards available for the Saturday for the highest double 70m/50m and the highest single 70m/50m.
