Venue	Barnsley Archery Club, BRUFC, Shaw Lane, Barnsley, South Yorkshire, S70 6HZ Please follow the direction signs from the car park to the tournament field.
Event Format	<p>Saturday 20 July - WRS WA 70/50m ranking round and head-to-head National Tour Stage 4 (Tier 1) Sunday 21 July - WRS WA double 70m/50m round (Tier 2+)</p> <p>For both days: Following practice, the WA 50m and 70m rounds will be shot to World Archery Rules. Compound - 80cm 6 ring faces at 50m, Barebow - 122cm 10 ring faces at 50m, and Recurve - 122cm 10 ring faces at 70m.</p> <p>Saturday - There will be a comfort break at three dozen. On completion of the ranking round, there will be a short break while the seedings are completed for the head-to-head rounds. Matches will be shot to current WA rules.</p> <p>There will be practice before each category commences and instructions given on the day. Higher placed archers may receive a bye in the earlier rounds. All archers per category will proceed to the eliminations.</p> <p>Sunday - There will be a short comfort break at three dozen during each round. There will be NO practice before the second round starts.</p> <p>Note: Music will be played during the event.</p>

Events Timings	<p>Saturday & Sunday:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Gates open at 7:30am - Registration and Equipment Inspection at 8:15am - Assembly at 8:45am - Practice – three ends of practice immediately after assembly. - Lunch durations will be announced on each of the days. - (Proof of Archery GB Membership should be made available on the day) - There is no practice available on Friday 19 July or on the evening of Saturday 20 July. - Line tents can be set up once the field of play is completed at approximately 6:00pm on Friday 19 July.
Categories	<p>Compound, Recurve and Barebow - World Archery rules apply. Longbow will compete in the Recurve division. Juniors will compete as adults.</p>

Awards	<p>Saturday - top three places for Compound, Recurve and Barebow men and women. Prize Money – will be paid out to the divisions noted above on Saturday only, amount dependant on entries. Sunday - top three places for Compound, Recurve and Barebow men and women.</p>
Entry Information	<p>£52.50 entry fee for the weekend All entries are via Sport:80 Open entries for all categories - 14 March 2024 at 7pm</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - A waiting list will be in operation as soon as the event is filled. - It is recommended that you log into your account ahead of the opening date to ensure details of people you wish to enter are up to date and hold a valid membership. - Please ensure the organiser is aware of any special requirements you may have. Archers who are unable to get to the target should arrange for an assistant to aid in scoring and arrow collection. If this is not possible, please contact the Tournament Organiser directly for advice.
Closing Date	<p>If you cancel your entry 28 days or more before the event, then you will receive a refund, less 20%. If you cancel after the 28-day limit there is no refund. Contact the organiser for cancellations barnsleyarchers@gmail.com</p>
Dress Code	<p>Please refer to the World Archery Rules of Shooting for the dress regulations. Archers should comply with dress regulations until after the presentations.</p>
Lost Arrows	<p>Lost arrows must be reported to a judge or member of the field party (please remember to inform them if you later find the arrow). It is the archer's responsibility to account for all your arrows before leaving the field.</p>

Bosses	Foam bosses for all archers.
Facilities	Toilets are provided in the main Shaw Lane building and on the field (inc disabled access). PLEASE BE AWARE: There is an incline up to the archery field entrances and some of the field surfaces can be slightly uneven for wheelchair users. If any archer needs assistance, please make a member of the field party aware and we can provide help, or if you wish to discuss further, please contact the Tournament Organiser.
Food	Hot/cold food, drinks and snacks will be available on both days.
Parking	Plenty of parking close to the tournament field.
Hotels	Plenty within a 5-10 minute drive of the venue.

Drug Testing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - No smoking/vaping or alcohol is allowed on the field of play or in the tent area. - This WRS shoot will be liable for drugs testing, and competitors approached to give samples must comply. Refusal will be treated as a positive result. - By entering this shoot Parents/Guardians give consent to under 18 Archers being tested if approached.
GDPR & Documents	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - By entering this event, you agree that the following information may be collected and shared with tournament organisers, scoring systems, Archery GB, and other competitors. Some information may also be published in documents or lists relating to the event, and at a schedule decided by the organisers. These include your name, gender, bow style, date of birth or age category, round, disability information, e-mail address, contact numbers, club, county, region, and any assigned codes for this information. - A target list will be published on the Ianseo website. - Any updates will appear on the Ianseo website.
