

## Archery School Competition Leagues (U15)

### Guidance for Organising a District League

The U15 Archery School v School Competition, designed to be a competition between two schools, can be played as part of a wider district Archery School Competition League too. See the *Organisation and Guidance* document for the *Archery School v School Competition* for the suggested competition format to use for the league competitions.

We hope that School Games Organisers will encourage schools to get involved in mini leagues with other local schools so regular competitions take place.

Suggested guidance is provided for School Games Organisers to help you arrange a local School Competition League.

<b>Name of competition</b>	Archery School Competition League
<b>Target group</b>	The target group for the competition format is students aged 11 to 14 (Key Stage 3 or year 7, 8 and 9), male, female or mixed.
<b>What level/location</b>	The competition is hosted by one of the schools – this can be either a sports hall or field.
<b>Who can run it</b>	Local schools, support from School Games Organisers.
<b>When does it take place</b>	The league can take place anytime throughout the year.  Schools must shoot against a minimum of 3 other schools as part of the league.
<b>What do we do now?</b>	Have a look on our school competition map on the website to see other schools nearby taking part in the School v School competition.  Contact the schools to agree their involvement in the league and confirm dates of the competitions.  Register your league with Archery GB using the League registration form. That way we can see which schools are taking part in regular competition and provide support where possible.  Enjoy your league School v School Competitions and complete the score sheet!

### Next steps after this competition

A Level 3 County archery competition as part of the School Games would be a good progression from the locally organised district league. For example, winners of the local leagues in each county could shoot against each other at the county finals.
