Six Gold Badge and Longbow Three Gold Badge

- (a) Separate Six Gold Badges are available for:
- (i) All archers shooting bows as recognised in Rules 303(a), 303(c) or 303(d) at the minimum distances specified for ladies and gentlemen.
 - (ii) All archers shooting bows as recognised in Rules 303(e) or 303(f) at the minimum distances specified for ladies and gentlemen
 - (iii) Junior archers shooting bows as recognised in Rules 303(a), 303(c) or 303(d) at the minimum distances specified for their age and gender.
 - (iv) Junior archers shooting bows as recognised in Rules 303(e) or 303(f) at the minimum distances specified for their age and gender.
- (b) The Three Gold Badge is only available for the Longbow and is achieved with a minimum of three gold ends under six gold end regulations.
- (c) For the purposes of the Six Gold End Badge only, when using 10-zone scoring the inner 10(X), inner gold (10) and outer gold (9) scoring rings will be treated as golds.
- (d) The shortest distances at which the Badge can be claimed are:

- (e) (i) Claims for the Badge must be submitted on the appropriate claim form.
- (ii) If the claim is made at a tournament the Tournament Organiser must sign the claim form. For Record Status Tournaments only please complete the form in the Record Status Tournament Book (See T.O.)
- (iii) If the Six Gold End is made at an associated club Target Day the Club the Secretary must sign the claim form.
- (f) An archer is entitled to only one Six Gold End Badge for each of the schemes given in (a) above.
