Event Timings	Assembly at 8:45am, with sighters at 9:00am on all three days.		
Event Format	<p><b>Wednesday and Thursday</b> – Double York for Gentlemen and Double Hereford for Ladies. Alternatively Ladies may shoot the Double National round.</p> <p><b>Friday</b> – Long National round for all Archers. Awards for this round will be decided on the GNAM handicap system.</p>		
Handicaps	Calculated up to the day before the meeting. Alterations to handicaps from those given on the entry form must be notified to the Tournament Organiser on the first day.		
Entry Fee	£47.50 for all 3 days		
Entry Information	<p>Entries to be submitted via the Sport:80 platform: <a href="https://agb.sport80.com">https://agb.sport80.com</a> or via the paper entry form available on our website.</p> <p>A waiting list will be in operation as soon as the event is filled. It is recommended that you log into your account ahead of the opening date to ensure details of people you wish to enter are up to date and hold a valid membership.</p> <p>Please ensure the organiser is aware of any special requirements you may have. Archers who are unable to get to the target should arrange for an assistant to aid in scoring and arrow collection. If this is not possible please contact the Tournament Organiser directly for advice.</p> <p>When you enter competitions the following information may be collected and shared with tournament organisers, scoring systems and other competitors for example target lists and results may be published: First Name, Surname, Gender, Bow style, Date of Birth / Age category, Email, Address, Phone number, Club (and ID), County (and ID), Region (and ID), Round (unless defined by age), Disabled (Y/N), Disability info.</p> <p>Music will be played during the event</p>		
Closing Date	<b>5 June 2018</b> If you cancel your entry 28 days, or more, before the event then you will receive a refund, less 20%. If you cancel after the 28 day limit there is no refund.

Presentation	Will take place immediately after lunch on Friday. All trophies must be returned to the organiser upon completion of presentations.		
Dress	Please refer to the Archery GB Rules of Shooting for the dress regulations. Archers should comply with dress regulations until after the presentations.		
Drug Testing	All archers are subject to drug testing, any archer approached by a doping control officer to give a sample must comply. Non-compliance is a breach of an anti-doping rule violation and will be treated as positive result		

	Parents / Guardians must sign the relevant box on the entry forms giving consent for junior archers (Under 18's) to be drug tested if approached.
Lost Arrows	Lost arrows must be reported to a judge or member of the field party (please remember to inform them if you later find the arrow). It is the archer's responsibility to account for all arrows before leaving the field.
Photography	In line with the recommendation in the Archery GB <a href="#">Safeguarding Children and Young People Policy</a> , the organisers of this event request that any person wishing to engage in any video, zoom or close range photography should register their details with Tournament Organiser at the registration desk before carrying out any such photography. If parents/carers have any particular concern about their child/young person being photographed or filmed they should notify the organisers. If you are concerned about any photography taking place at this event, please contact the tournament organiser directly.
Refreshments	Tea/Coffee and biscuits will be available during the breaks from the organiser's tent.
