Event Timings	<p>Local archers are asked to enter the first or second session to allow other archers with long journeys to have time to make them. Indicate clearly in which session you wish to shoot.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Session "A" – Assembly 08.30am – Sighters will follow assembly • Session "B" – Assembly 10.45am – Sighters will follow assembly • Session "C" – Assembly 14.00pm – Sighters will follow assembly <p>Please note that it's expected that the 08.30am Session will be shot in a single detail, with only 2 Archers per target. Depending on entries, this may be subject to change.</p>

Event Format	<p>Archers may choose the type of face they wish to shoot at, irrespective of section. Full size 60cm face or 3 spot vertical face. This must be specified at time of entry. Awards	<p>No other archer, than a British National of the United Kingdom may be a British Champion. The titles of National Champion will be held by the Boy and Girl with the highest score irrespective of age. In all sections 1st, 2nd and 3rd places will be awarded.</p> <p>These championships are open to any Junior member of Archery GB or a W.A. member association.</p>

Scoring	Please be aware that parents will be expected to help with the scoring.

Dress	<p>Please refer to the Archery GB Rules of Shooting for the dress regulations.</p> <p>Archers should comply with dress regulations until after the presentations.</p>

Drug Testing	<p>Archers competing at record status tournaments may be liable for drugs testing. Competitors who are approached to give samples must comply.</p> <p>Non-compliance will be treated as a positive result.</p> <p>Parents / Guardians must sign the relevant box on the entry forms giving consent for junior archers (Under 18's) to be drug tested if approached.</p>

Photography	<p>In line with the recommendation in the Archery GB Safeguarding Children and Young People Policy, the organisers of this event request that any person wishing to engage in any video, zoom or close range photography should register their details with Tournament Organiser at the registration desk before carrying out any such photography. If parents/carers have any particular concern about their child/young person being photographed or filmed they should notify the organisers.</p> <p>Please note in line with the Photographing & Filming Children & Young People in Sport policy you may be required to obtain written permission from the subject and/or their parents/carers to publish images on the internet or in print.</p> <p>Archery GB reserves the right to decline entry to any person unable to meet or abide by these conditions.</p> <p>If you are concerned about any photography taking place at this event, please contact the tournament organiser.</p>
Special Notes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Archers who are unable to get to the target should discuss their requirements with the organiser to see what options are available to aid in scoring and arrow collection. • Please expect music to be played at a low level during shooting. • Space is limited in the hall and as such the front row of chairs will be dedicated to those Juniors competing in the current session. Parents and supporters must occupy the chairs behind. Please do not be offended if you are asked to move by the Judges or Work Party, otherwise we may ask you to leave the hall entirely and it puts at jeopardy the number of supporters we will allow into the hall next year per competitor.

As spaces become available they will be offered to Archers in strict order from that list.</p>
