Registration	<p>Venue will open from 07:30 for Registration.</p> <p>Membership cards <u>will</u> be required for booking in.</p> <p>If you are not yet in possession of a 2018/2019 card, please bring proof that you have paid your membership to your club.</p>
Event Timings	<p>Session A – will commence at 08.30am with 2 practice ends</p> <p>Session B – will commence at 11.30am with 2 practice ends</p> <p>There will be no restriction on bowstyle in either session this year.</p> <p>Shoot-offs for 32nd place will take place at 15.00pm</p> <p>The 1/16 Head to Heads will commence at 15.30pm starting with 2 practice ends.</p> <p>The expected timeline for the rest of the afternoon will be 1/8 – 16.30pm, 1/4 – 17.10pm, 1/2 – 17.50pm, Medal Matches – 18.30pm and the presentation ceremony at 19.15pm.</p> <p>Un sighted categories will be allocated places subject to entries. Please be prepared to swap from your chosen session. If Barebow archers wish to participate in the Head to Head they must enter as a Recurve.</p> <p>The awards ceremony for the teams and other categories decided on the W.A. 18m scores will be held during the afternoon. The awards for the head to head matches will be presented after the finals have been completed.</p>
Awards	<p>National Trophies and the Championship Title will be awarded to the highest placed British Archery GB members. After the presentation, all trophies must be returned to the Tournament Organiser.</p> <p>Note – Only Archery GB members will be allowed to proceed to the W.A. Indoor Match Round. Medals will be awarded on the following basis. 1-3 Archers – 1st. 4-6 Archers – 2nd, 7+ Archers – 3rd.</p>
Home Nations	<p>This event will host the Home Nations match. Team Managers should be aware that spaces will be reserved for their teams, however on the closing date, any unfilled spaces <u>WILL</u> be handed over to archers on the waiting list.</p> <p><i>Archers expecting to be part of a team should still submit an entry along with payment to guarantee their space before the closing date.</i></p>
Event Format	<p>All Recurve and Compound archers will shoot a WA 18m Round on a vertical 3-spot 40cm face. Longbow archers will shoot on a 40cm full face.</p> <p>The top 32 Archery GB members of each gender, recurve and compound disciplines will progress to the W.A. Indoor Match Round. Match Rounds for Longbow archers will be run providing more than 4 archers enter, otherwise Longbow awards will be made on the basis of the W.A. 18m round.</p>
Dress	<p>Please refer to the Archery GB Rules of Shooting for the dress regulations.</p> <p>Archers should comply with dress regulations until after the presentations.</p>
Drug Testing	<p>Archers competing at record status tournaments may be liable for drugs testing. Competitors who are approached to give samples must comply.</p> <p>Non-compliance will be treated as a positive result.</p> <p>Parents / Guardians must sign the relevant box on the entry forms giving consent for junior archers (Under 18's) to be drug tested if approached.</p>

Refreshments	Food will be available in the foyer. Drinks and snacks may be consumed in the hall.
Photography	<p>In line with the recommendation in the Archery GB Safeguarding Children and Young People Policy, the organisers of this event request that any person wishing to engage in any video, zoom or close range photography should register their details with Tournament Organiser at the registration desk before carrying out any such photography. If parents/carers have any particular concern about their child/young person being photographed or filmed they should notify the organisers.</p> <p>Please note in line with the Photographing & Filming Children & Young People in Sport policy you may be required to obtain written permission from the subject and/or their parents/carers to publish images on the internet or in print.</p> <p>Archery GB reserves the right to decline entry to any person unable to meet or abide by these conditions.</p> <p>If you are concerned about any photography taking place at this event, please contact the tournament organiser.</p>
Special Notes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Archers who are unable to get to the target should discuss their requirements with the organiser to see what options are available to aid in scoring and arrow collection. • Please expect music to be played at a low level during shooting. • Space is limited in the hall and as such the front row of chairs will be dedicated to those Juniors competing in the current session. Parents and supporters must occupy the chairs behind. Please do not be offended if you are asked to move by the Judges or Work Party, otherwise we may ask you to leave the hall entirely and it puts at jeopardy the number of supporters we will allow into the hall next year per competitor.
Car Parking	Parking will be available near to the hall onsite for free
