Event Info:	Chaperoning of athletes is the parent/guardian’s responsibility. An updated schedule and match plan will be published prior to the event and updates will be communicated as soon as practicable to all athletes. Athletes must be able to attend the whole weekend for entries to be accepted.
Event Format:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> 22 June Day 1: Official Practice and 70m/60m & 50m Ranking Rounds, individual H2Hs, Team and Team matches 23 June Day 2: Individual H2H, Team and Team finals <p>Following the ranking round, participants will be grouped into tiers of up to eight athletes each. Subsequent head to heads will take place within each tier.</p> <p>If more than one athlete is tied for entry into a tier, a shoot off may be held to determine placing. If there are insufficient participants in a tier, categories may be merged to form a complete tier.</p>
Age Groups:	<p>Junior and cadet age groups are in line with World Archery Age Groups.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Recurve: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Junior 70m – 4.2.4. An athlete may participate in a Junior Class in tournaments when the competition takes place up to and in the year of their 20th birthday Cadet 60m – 4.2.3. An athlete may participate in a Cadet Class in tournaments when the competition takes place up to and in the year of their 17th birthday. Cubs 50m UNDER 14 - An athlete may participate in a Cadet Class in tournaments when the competition takes place up to and in the year of their 14th birthday Compound <ul style="list-style-type: none"> 50m – 4.2.4. An athlete may participate in one Class in tournaments when the competition takes place up to and in the year of their 20th birthday



Teams:	Team compositions are dependent on entry numbers and age groups. Teams will be allocated at the event after the ranking round by drawn allocation.
Dress:	Please refer to the Archery GB Rules of Shooting for the dress regulations. Archers should comply with dress regulations until the event finishes.
Drug Testing:	Archers competing at record status tournaments may be liable for drugs testing. Competitors who are approached to give samples must comply. Non-compliance will be treated as a positive result. Parents / Guardians must sign the relevant box on the entry forms giving consent for junior archers (under 18s) to be drug tested if approached.
Photography:	In line with the recommendation in the Archery GB Safeguarding Policy, those who wish to take photographs or video at this event must register with the Tournament Secretary on arrival. All athletes will be asked to download a photo release form during Sport80 entry and bring the completed form to registration on Day 1.
Refreshments:	There will be a van on site throughout the two-day shoot covering breakfast and lunch requirements
Accommodation:	There is no accommodation on site. Athletes are asked to make their own arrangements.
