



## 2020 Archery GB National Tour – Stage Applications

Applications are invited from clubs, Counties or Regions associations to host a stage of the 2020 Archery GB National Tour. Competitions hosting requirements are outlined in this document.

Due to the popularity and support for the National Tour, any 2020 competition venues should have the capacity for a minimum of 50 targets giving space for 200 competitors. We can now consider a venue doing separate days for both recurve and compound if they have over 28 targets.

All stages for 2020 must fit into a set calendar window, on one of the nominated weekends:

- May 2,3,30,31
- July 11,12,18,19
- June 13,14
- August 29,30
- September 5,6

The format of the competition is to be World Record Status, and as follows:

- A WA 70m round with Individual Head to Head round for recurve
- A WA 50m round with Individual Head to Head round for compound
- There is a host fee of £300 plus VAT for a single event or £500 plus VAT for a two-day event.
  - Hosting fees are used to fund the Finals event as the National Tour is non-profit and fully self-funded from external sponsorship.
- All entries are to be managed on Archery GB's membership portal entry platform (more info available on request).
- All entries will be subject to the Archery GB Terms & Conditions, which must be followed for cancellations or changes.
- The name of the competition is to be "The Archery GB National Tour Stage X&X" hosted by XXXX or "XXXX incorporating the Archery GB National Tour Stage XX"
- The National Tour Logo is to appear on each entry prospectus and all printed items for the competition.
- Places for the 30 top ranked archers in the Archery GB National Rankings in both the men's and women's recurve and compound divisions will be put on advance sale one week ahead of the general sale.
- All opening dates must be agreed with the Archery GB Events Manager and will be published on the Archery GB website in advance.

- From experience, we recommend that entry is open four months before the event.
- The recommended minimum entry fee for a single archer is £42.50 for a two-day event or £25.00 for a single day.
- **For 2020 would you please consider using the same prize money pay-out system as the Bucks or Bounty (BOB) are operating at their event and offer two entry prices. This is proving very popular in the BOB event. Details on how the BOB competition works can be found here: <http://www.bucksorbounty.co.uk/how-it-works.html>**
- The AGB Competitions team will provide the following equipment and services towards your event.
  - Management of entries and waiting lists on Sport 80
  - Target list allocation to your specification
  - Set up of all lanseo files including online
  - Back numbers printed and delivered on tear proof paper and pins
  - Provision of a results team leader for the weekend
  - Delivery of a full results service
  - Supply of the AGB score system (PDA's)
  - Supply of the AGB flippy boards
  - Loan of target nappies if required
  - Loan of a Sound System
  - Loan of a Damage Timing System
- It is mandatory that the competition is scored on IANSEO software, so that full and immediate results and standings will go live onto the internet. Therefore, you will need to supply power at the score tent
  - AGB are now running lanseo courses if you are interested in this going forward
- The Club/County/Region will be responsible for appointing Judges. Please contact the Regional Judge Liaison Officer. Full contact details can be provided if necessary
- There should be an effective public-address system and we would like you to consider playing music while archers collect their arrows from the targets
- The use of A-Frame stands is prohibited at National Tour events. All frames must be H frame style. It is preferred that foam targets are used if possible
- In addition, an area for banners of National Tour sponsors and possibly display stands from any Tour sponsors will be required
- We would like you to seek local publicity and sponsorship of your National Tour Stage
