Archery GB membership cards should be available if requested. Venue organisers may refuse entry without AGB membership cards, valid membership receipts or membership of a World Archery affiliated organisation.

Awards: **A Champion's medal and trophy will be awarded to the highest scoring British senior and junior of each gender.**
 Championship medals will be awarded according to entry numbers in the Senior and Junior, Lady's and Gentlemen's, categories. All medals will be sent by post after the event.
 Masters and each junior age category will receive medals according to entry. Entrants to the Masters classes will also be eligible for the senior championship.
 Home Nations Trophy: Highest combined score from one senior male, female & junior (boy or girl) Club Trophy: Highest combined score from one senior male, female & junior (boy or girl).
 University: Highest combined score from one gentleman & one lady from the same university (medals only) Couples' Trophy: Highest scoring married couple.

Please note that costs of engraving the national trophies will be refunded by the T.O. on application.

Other Details: Subject to space being available, archers in other disciplines may shoot, but will be put on a holding register and will not be advised if space is available until Tuesday 19th November 2019
 There will be NO awards for other disciplines, except at the discretion of the venue organiser, but records may be claimed.

Dress: **Dress regulations as shown in Rule 307 will apply. Please do not attend the shoot wearing jeans, as you will not be allowed to shoot.**

Special needs: Archers with physical impairment are asked to note any special needs on the entry form, so that appropriate provisions may be made.

Drug Testing: Archers will be liable for drug testing and competitors approached to give samples must comply. If they refuse, that refusal will be treated as a positive result.

Photography: In view of the provisions of the Protection of Children and Vulnerable Adults Policy, those who wish to take photographs at this event are to register with the Venue Organiser on arrival. No unauthorised photography will be permitted.

Target List: Target lists will be sent as soon as possible after the closing date via e-mail only. Target lists may be subject to change on the day. Please do not make enquiries with undue haste: there is a great deal to do after the closing date!
