Selection process, Full description below.	<p>Athletes will move through three stages of a selection process:</p> <p>Stage 1 – Qualify for selection shoot</p> <p>Stage 2 - Selection and ratification of the team</p> <p>Stage 3 - Representation. Selected athletes will be required to maintain or improve their standards in line with the selection criteria in order to participate in the event and represent Great Britain.</p> <p>Athletes are required to complete all stages of the selection process to be eligible for selection. Should an athlete not be able to participate in part of the selection process due to illness, injury or international representation, they will need approved medical or programme exemption from Archery GB personnel. Further consideration of this athlete will be done in line with criteria below.</p>								
Nomination and Selection Panel	<p>Following the completion of the designated selection process listed in this policy, the Performance Director will take into account a range of views deemed necessary to discuss the nomination of the athletes from the Compound Programme Manager and further staff from the Compound National Squad Coaching staff.</p>								
The ‘Team’	<p>The ‘Team’ means the team, which is selected by Archery GB which includes athletes, coaches, nominated reserves, medical support personnel, team leaders and any associated members of the World Class Programme team.</p>								

<p>Appeals</p>	<p>Appeals against process must be submitted within 72 hours of the selection announcement on the dates stipulated above.</p> <p>Appeals will be conducted according to the policy on the Archery GB website, which can be downloaded from the following location:</p> <p>http://www.archerygb.org/wp-content/uploads/2017/05/SP2302UKSportFundedProgrammesAppealsPolicy160527-20801.pdf</p>
<p>Following the conclusion of the selection process</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Once athletes have been advised of their selection by Archery GB, they must agree not to withhold any information on availability, fitness, injury status or illness that could affect their training or competitiveness at any time until the conclusion of the event; 2. All selected athletes must declare any medications they are taking, in particular the use of any restricted medications and that they hold a valid Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE) which can be produced when required by the relevant authority; 3. An athlete will be required to sign up to the Team Members’ Agreement and any breach of this may result in disciplinary action including removal from the team and possible early return home from an event. In this case, any member sent home will be invoiced for the full cost of their entry into the event and any additional cost incurred in sending them home. Decisions on these matters are open to appeal as allowed by the relevant Archery GB Disciplinary process effective at the time of the incident. 4. Athletes selected for the team are required to attend all related training camps and competitions agreed in the required event preparation process from the selection announcement onwards. 5. Athletes and other team members will be expected to demonstrate they can actively contribute to the team unity required to be a successful international team and will be required to maintain or improve standards and behaviours to participate for Archery GB.

<p>STAGE 1: Qualify for Selection Process</p>	<p>Minimum standards are set for entry into the selection process.</p> <p>1. Qualification for Selection Process</p> <p>Archery GB will track the performance trajectories of athletes in line with <i>what it takes to win</i> in the International Stage</p> <p>1.1 Athletes can qualify between 1 April 2019 and 28 March 2020</p> <p>1.2 These scores must be obtained at World Record Status Events.</p> <p>1.3 It is the athlete’s sole responsibility to ensure they register their scores and that those scores have been accepted onto that system.</p> <p>1.4 To gain an entry invite you must send your qualification scores to Jon.Nott@archerygb.org</p> <p>1.5 Registration into the Selection Shoot will be through the Sport80 system.</p> <p>1.6 Athletes must have registered their scores and entered the Selection competition latest 28 March 2020</p> <p>1.7 Archery GB also reserves the right to take into consideration other aspects, including athlete conduct and previous performances, when considering invitations to the selection process. It is not an athlete’s right under any circumstances to be invited. Where other elements are taken into account, the athlete has a right to be given the explanation as well as a right to appeal.</p>

2. Performance Standards for Consideration to be Invited to the Selection Process

Minimum performance standards have been set for Archery GB to allow athletes to qualify for the selection process.

These scores **do not** constitute a minimum level for consideration for nomination or selection, **only** a minimum standard set for athletes to engage in the process.

The minimum thresholds on a 50m - round set are:

<p>STAGE 2: Gaining Nomination and Performance Standards for Nomination</p>	<p>3. Doing <i>what it takes to win</i></p> <p>3.1 Archery GB will only select athletes who can demonstrate the ability to consistently execute an accurate shot, by quickly adapting and competing under pressure, in a variety of conditions over a period of time. Athletes’ performance will be tracked through a series of selection events. WORLD CUP STAGES GUATAMALA 1, ANTALYA 2

(SELF-FUNDED)

Up to 4 places per discipline

Athletes with qualification scores must express interest to attended by 02/02/2020 for Guatemala & 06/04/2020 for Antalya

If more than 4 athletes apply the 3 athletes with top scores will attend, + 1 place coach selection

Total Score is made up from 2 x 50m and 4 x Head 2 Head Matches only at WRS events.

- MEN TOTAL SCORE = 1996
- WOMEN TOTAL SCORE = 1960

Scores accepted from 1 April 2019

If less than 3 athletes meet the required score, the Performance Director can elect to offer out remaining spaces to an athlete ranked top 8 in UK, as long as they have obtained the Euro GP level qualification standard.

EUROPEAN GRAND PRIX POREC, JUNE 2020

(SELF-FUNDED EVENT)

Up to 6 Athlete places per discipline

Athletes with qualification scores must express interest to attend no later than 16 March 2020.

If more than 6 athletes apply the 6 athletes with top total of qualification scores will attend.

This is a self-funded event.

Minimum qualification score for event attendance from 1 April 2019.

Total Score is made up from 2 x 50m and 4 x Head 2 Head Matches only at WRS events.

- MEN TOTAL SCORE – 1978
- WOMEN TOTAL SCORE – 1950

This event is intended as a development event.**
