Introduction

Archers, coaches and club officials of all levels are keen to receive information in helping them learn and advance the sport.

The Spring Training Programme offers online support to strengthen members and clubs to grow our sport. It is built on the success, feedback and learnings of previous webinars and in person workshops. The training opportunities allow delegates to grow, share their knowledge and experience and meet others from the archery community.

Progression of archers, and development of clubs are key priorities for Archery GB. All archers want to experience achievement, enjoyment and a sense of progress in their personal development and as a club. The training could also help in attracting and equipping new or potential volunteers, as we seek to grow the sport.



Who should attend?

Most of the events are open to all members. Some are tailored to specific role holders such as coaches, people running clubs, organisers of competitive opportunities for archers, or other club officials. Webinars are also a great way to encourage new people to consider new roles within the club.

Online considerations

Most webinars will include a chance to be fully interactive, therefore a laptop/PC/tablet is recommended, but smartphone may also be possible- with limited functionality in some cases. The device must have access to a microphone to be able to interact during the session.

Ideally participants would have good WIFI access, and an environment with limited distractions which is conducive to learning. It is recommended to log into the webinar around 5-10 minutes ahead of the designated start time, to overcome any technical difficulties logging in.
