

## RETURN TO ARCHERY (WALES) – FROM 13 MARCH 2021

OUTDOOR ARCHERY ONLY	
SOCIAL DISTANCING & HYGIENE	Maintain 2 metre social distancing at all times
	All must ensure they cleanse their hands before and after shooting
TRAVEL	Stay local – approx. 5 mile travelling distance
TARGET BOSSES	Minimum spacing of boss centres of 3.66m*
CLUB SESSIONS & TARGET DAYS	Maximum of 2 archers or 1 household/bubble per target boss – maintaining 2m social distancing at all times
NUMBERS ON RANGE	Restrict range attendance to maximum of 4 archers from 2 household – clarity on numbers permitted being sought from Welsh Government
COACHING	1:1 permitted Groups of 4 people from 2 households, inclusive of the coach
BEGINNERS	Have a Go's – not permitted Taster Sessions & Beginners Courses – Groups of 4 people from 2 households, inclusive of the coach
OPEN COMPETITIONS	Club activities only
CLUBHOUSE / FACILITIES	Indoor meeting areas, ranges and kitchens closed but indoor toilets may open

- Away from the shooting line socialising should be restricted to the 4 people from 2 households.
