

OUTDOOR ARCHERY	
SOCIAL DISTANCING & HYGIENE	Maintain 2 metre social distancing at all times
	All must ensure they cleanse their hands before and after shooting
TRAVEL	No restrictions but think carefully about the journeys you take
TARGET BOSSES	Minimum spacing of boss centres of 3.66m ¹
CLUB SESSIONS & TARGET DAYS	Maximum of 2 archers or 1 household/bubble per target boss – maintaining 2m social distancing at all times or shooting details
NUMBERS ON RANGE	Outdoor regulated activities can take place (maximum limit of 4000)
COACHING	1:1 permitted; Groups up to 12 archers per coach permitted ²
BEGINNERS	Have a Go's – not permitted; Taster Sessions & Beginners Courses – Groups up to 12 archers per coach permitted ²
OPEN COMPETITIONS	UKRS & WRS competitions permitted
CLUBHOUSE / FACILITIES	Clubhouses and pavilions can open for social activity and indoor hospitality for individual households or up to six people from no more than six households (not including children under 11 from the households or carers of a member of these households).

¹ Away from the shooting line socialising should be restricted to 6 people from 2 households

INDOOR ARCHERY	
SOCIAL DISTANCING & HYGIENE	Maintain 2 metre social distancing at all times
	All must ensure they cleanse their hands before and after shooting
	Face covering must be worn except when actively shooting (exemptions include disabled archers and under 12s)
TRAVEL	Minimise travel and reduce the number of journeys you make
TARGET BOSSES	Minimum spacing of boss centres of 2m; Protective screens on the shooting line (not needed if target spacing is 3.3m)
CLUB SESSIONS	Maximum of 2 archers or 1 household/bubble per target boss – maintaining 2m social distancing at all times or shooting details Range attendance is a maximum of 30 adults inclusive of coaches and volunteers. See exemptions below.
COACHING	1:1 permitted; Groups up to 12 archers per coach permitted ³
BEGINNERS	Have a Go's – not permitted; Taster Sessions & Beginners Courses – Groups up to 12 archers per coach permitted ³
OPEN COMPETITIONS	Maximum of 30 adults permitted, inclusive of coaches, judges and other volunteers.
CLUBHOUSE / FACILITIES	Clubhouses and pavilions can open for social activity and indoor hospitality for individual households or up to six people from no more than six households (not including children under 11 from the households or carers of a member of these households).
EXEMPTIONS	Organised activities for elite athletes; No limit to group size for children and young people under 18. Children aged 11 and older are required to maintain 2 metre social distancing AT ALL TIMES when participating indoors.
