<p>1. Competition Format/s</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Individual • Mixed Team • Team <p>Maximum places per category as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 3 x Compound Women • 3 x Compound Men
<p>2. General Points of Eligibility</p>	<p>Archers are eligible for consideration provided they are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • An Archery GB member in good standing • Have satisfied all eligibility under the rules of World Archery (WA) and subject to any changes it may introduce subsequent to the publication of this policy • Available for selection of the stated event • Hold a current full UK passport, valid for at least six months after return date of the event • Have met the selection scores (see below)
<p>3. Milestone Event Performance Target/s</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 1 Medal • 1 European Games qualification spot
<p>4. Context and Purpose of Milestone Event and Championship selection</p>	<p>AGB will use this event to maximise the opportunity to achieve medal winning performances at this event and future events; as well as secure quota spots for the European Games.</p>

<p>5. Selection Window</p>	<p>The window for attainment of scores will be May 01 – 2021 – April 04 - 2022</p>									
<p>6. Selection process</p>	<p>Selection will be a 3-stage process:</p> <p>Stage 1 is shooting selection scores and submitting them by a set date.</p> <p>Stage 2 is the completion of selection shoot if necessary</p> <p>Stage 3 is the selection of the team</p>									
<p>7. STAGE 1: Selection Scores</p>	<table border="1" data-bbox="513 757 1437 943"> <thead> <tr> <th></th> <th>Compound Men</th> <th>Compound Women</th> </tr> </thead> <tbody> <tr> <td>Tier 1 scores 2 x Scores Required</td> <td>WA 50m round = 704 H2H = 148</td> <td>WA 50m round = 696 H2H = 146</td> </tr> <tr> <td>Tier 2 scores 3 x Scores Required</td> <td>WA 50m round = 696</td> <td>WA 50m round = 685</td> </tr> </tbody> </table> <p>If 3 or less athletes gain Tier 1 scores, they will be automatically selected for the European Championships team, however they will be required to maintain form and fitness in the window between achieving scores and the event.</p> <p>If 4 or more athletes gain Tier 1 scores a selection shoot will be triggered in that category which will follow the process identified in section 8. <p>8. STAGE 2: Selection Shoot</p>	<p>In the event that a selection shoot is required after spots have been automatically allocated to those with Tier 1 scores, the selection shoot will take place on the weekend of April 9/10 at Lillehall.</p> <p>If selection is required in any discipline, the process by which athletes are ranked for the remaining spots will be as follows:</p> <p>1. Tournament Scoring:</p> <p>Scores from the following events will be used to give athletes an opportunity to demonstrate consistency of performance:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• 3 x WA50m round scores used from qualification (these will be your scores used to qualify from any WRS event in the selection period) <p>2. Selection Shoot Scoring April 2022 Day 1;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• 1 x 50m round + Head-to-Head score from Day 1. <p>3. Selection Shoot Scoring April 2022 Day 2:</p> <p>The following format will be used to give athletes an opportunity to demonstrate match play competitiveness and performance: Format can be subject to change with 7 days' notice:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• 36 arrows qualifier round in ends of 3 arrows• Head-to-head matches (Number announced week before) <p>Selection Shoot Ranking:</p> <p>For those who are competing in the selection shoot, all arrows shot through 'Tournament Scoring' and the points scored through the 'Selection Shoot' will be added together for total score to form the selection shoot ranking.</p> <p>A 2% bonus will be given for any scores over the qualification Tier 1 standard, for each 5 points over these scores an additional 1% will be added. This is available at all stages of the process.</p> <p>The Tier 1 scores for bonus at 50m and H2H are;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">○ Men 704 / 148○ Women 696 / 146 <p>This will give each athlete a finishing position and will form the basis of selection.</p>

<p>9. STAGE 3: Selection Panel</p>	<p>Following the conclusion of the selection process, a selection panel will be convened to confirm selections for the event. The Panel will consider only athletes deemed to be competitive at this level, and may elect to take fewer than the maximum permitted athletes for these events.</p> <p>The representatives at this meeting will be made up of the following;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Performance Director (Chair) • Compound Programme Manager • Compound National Squad Coaching Staff (as appropriate) • Performance Archery Staff (as appropriate) • Performance Co-ordinator (Meeting notes) <p>In selecting a team that is in keeping with the context and aims of event selection in section 3, the panel will consider all available information, including, but not limited to athletes who have been unable to train or compete due to injury / illness or any other unforeseen circumstances, maintenance of form and fitness, performance readiness, performance potential, medal target, performance pedigree (including international medals won), injury/illness history, behaviour and contribution to a team ethos.</p>
<p>10. Wildcard(s)</p>	<p>In the event that there is a selection shoot for those with Tier 2 scores, consideration will be given to whether any wildcards are awarded for the selection shoot.</p> <p>For a wildcard to be awarded, an athlete must have hit a minimum of two of the Tier 2 scores within the selection window and there have been extenuating circumstances as to why they haven't hit all of them or had the same opportunity to do so. Extenuating circumstances may include, but not be limited to, international representation and injury or illness.</p>
<p>11. Process for Injury/Illness</p>	<p>At all stages of the selection process, athletes are expected to be honest and open and not to withhold any information on injury status or physical / mental health that could affect their training or competitiveness at any time until the conclusion of the event.</p> <p>In the event that an athlete is unable to take part in the selection process due to injury status, physical / mental health concerns, shielding requirements, or any COVID related reasons, the selection panel may still consider this athlete for a selection shoot and / or selection.</p>

	To be eligible for consideration the athlete is required to provide any medical evidence supporting their injury status or physical / mental health concern and the timescales relating to the impact of the injury / illness on performance.
12. The 'Team'	The 'Team' means the team which is selected by Archery GB which includes athletes, coaches, nominated reserves, medical support personnel, team leaders and any associated members of the World Class Programme team.
13. Appeals	Any selection appeal must be registered in line with the process identified in the Performance Appeals Policy which can be found here - http://www.archerygb.org/national-squads-records/selection-criteria/
14. Following the conclusion of the selection process	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Once athletes have been advised of their selection by Archery GB, they must agree not to withhold any information on availability, fitness, injury status or illness that could affect their training or competitiveness at any time until the conclusion of the event; 2. All selected athletes must declare any medications they are taking, in particular the use of any restricted medications and that they hold a valid Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE) which can be produced when required by the relevant authority; 3. An athlete will be required to sign up to the Team Members' Agreement and any breach of this may result in disciplinary action including removal from the team and possible early return home from an event. In this case, any member sent home will be invoiced for the full cost of their entry into the event and any additional cost incurred in sending them home. Decisions on these matters are open to appeal as allowed by the relevant Archery GB Disciplinary process effective at the time of the incident. 4. Athletes selected for the team are required to attend all related training camps and competitions agreed in the required event preparation process from the selection announcement onwards. 5. Athletes and other team members will be expected to demonstrate they can actively contribute to the team unity required to be a successful international team and will be required to maintain or improve standards and behaviours to participate for Archery GB.
15. Announcement	Selected team members must agree not to make any announcement to the media or public in any form (including on any social or other media)

	regarding their selection until after Archery GB have announced the selection on the Archery GB website www.archerygb.org
16. Any matters not covered by this Policy	Any matters arising from the selection processes, which are not covered within this policy, shall be determined by The Performance Director and (or representative thereof) in conjunction with the Compound Programme Manager.

APPENDICES FOR 2022

World Games 2022 Birmingham, Alabama, USA

The 2022 World Games requires athletes to win places at events in 2021 at the European Championships, World Archery Championships or through World Ranking.

This policy only relates to any spots won at the aforementioned qualification tournaments and doesn't pertain to the allocated spot via the Paralympic games, which may be subject to a separate selection process.

If an athlete wins a space for the 2022 World Games the space won will be awarded to them on the following basis:

- The athlete is shooting competitively and consistently shooting over the tier 2 qualification level at competitions in 2022.
- The athlete is following an agreed plan with the Compound Programme Manager.

World Cups / European Grand-Prix

In 2022 there are 4 world cups and 1 European GP.

Once the World Archery calendar and dates are known one event will be selected as the pre-Europeans training event. (Funding will be made clear for this before the event)

A minimum of 2 spots to the other events will be offered out to all qualified athletes to attend on a self-funded basis.

Selection will be in the following order for the available events 3 months prior to the event:

All athletes who have qualified for the European championship's selection competition will have their best 3 x 50m scores added together from the selection period, this will form a ranking list and spaces will be offered in rank order to all qualified athletes.
